

Over 7,500 children are born each year in Stanislaus County.

Out of **10** children born, **6** are of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity and **3** are White. At least **1** is either Asian, Black or of Multiple-Race.





6 out of 10 children enrolled in school in Stanislaus County are Hispanic/Latino ethnicity,

3 are White. \triangleright



About **4-5** out of **10** children in school are at some level of English Proficiency, especially in the Kindergarten and early grade.

3 out of every **10** 12th graders are "University Ready". ³

On average, Stanislaus County
has 2 child deaths per
10,000 population every
other year. That is 2 child
deaths per neighborhood
every other year.4

95% of the population in Stanislaus County have Health Insurance Coverage.²



2% of deaths due to alcohol or drugs in Stanislaus County is seen among children under 19 years. 4/5
